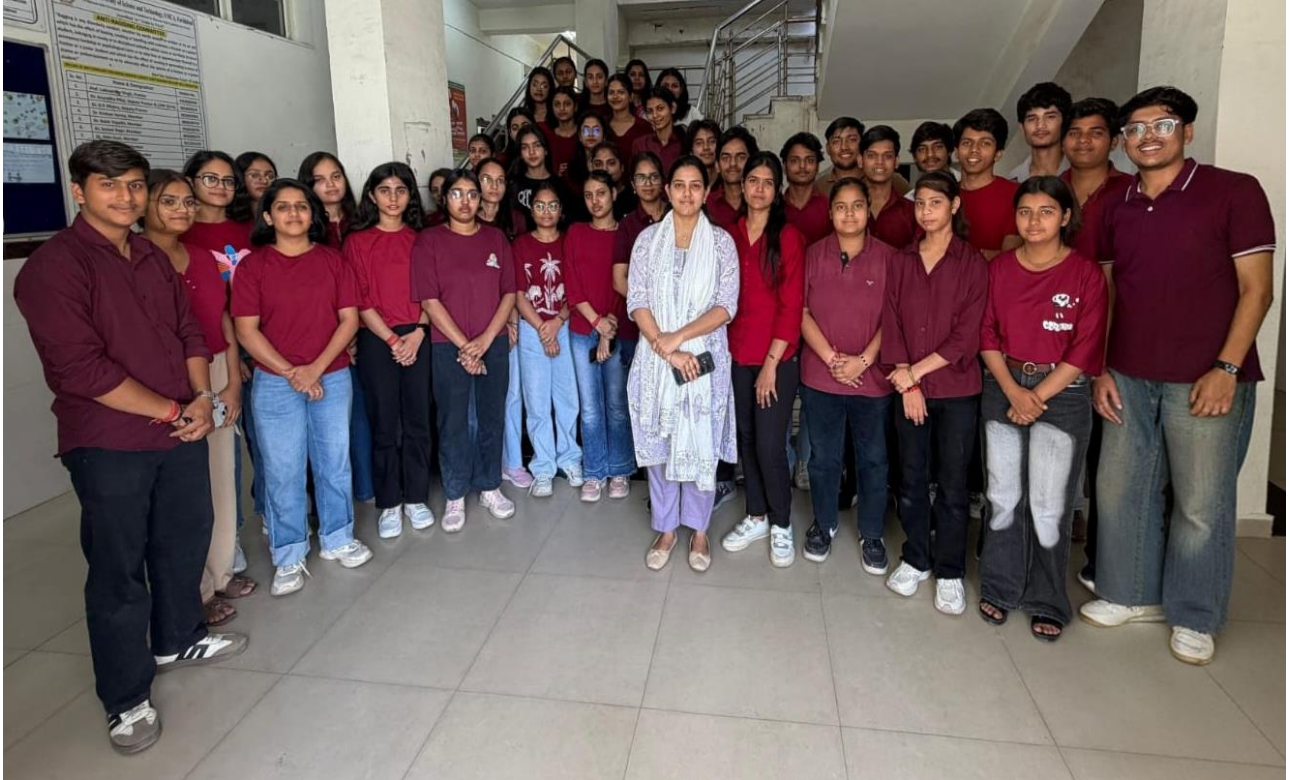

The aim of the commerce quiz competition was to create awareness about various aspects of commerce and the business environment. The session aimed to encourage students to enhance their knowledge of subjects like accounting, economics, and business studies, while also developing quick thinking and analytical skills. It also sought to promote a spirit of healthy competition, improve general awareness about the corporate world, and build confidence among students through active participation. A total of 40 students of B.Com (H) enthusiastically participated in the quiz.



The quiz comprised of three rounds:

The first round of the quiz was designed to test participants' knowledge of basic business and commerce-related topics. A total of 5 objective-type questions were asked, each with four possible answers. Participants were given a time limit of 30 seconds to answer all questions. The questions covered a wide range of topics including Economics, Financial Markets, Marketing and so on. 30 students qualified for the second round.



The second round of the quiz was designed to further challenge the participants with a higher level of difficulty. Building on the fundamentals tested in the first round, this stage featured more complex and analytical questions from areas such as Economics, Financial Markets, and Marketing. Participants were required to think critically and apply their conceptual understanding under time constraints. The increased difficulty level ensured a more rigorous evaluation of their knowledge and problem-solving abilities. 6 students qualified for the third round.



The third round of the quiz was a visual and branding challenge. In this round, participants were shown a series of well-known logos, taglines and entrepreneurs from various businesses, and they had to correctly identify the company or brand that these belonged to. This round tested participants' awareness of major brands and their marketing strategies, especially in terms of logo design and slogan creation, which are essential components of brand identity. The round also highlighted the importance of branding in the global commercial world.



The competition was intense, but it also fostered a sense of camaraderie and learning among the participants. At the end of the quiz, the first position was secured by Kunal Saini followed by the second position secured by Abhinav Mishra , while Shivam Jindal secured the third position. The winners were congratulated and applauded for their excellent performance. The session ended on a positive and motivating note, encouraging all students to actively participate in such academic activities to enhance their knowledge and analytical skills.

The session witnessed enthusiastic participation from students, where participants actively took part in different rounds of the commerce quiz competition. Students demonstrated their knowledge by answering questions related to accounting, economics, and business studies with confidence and clarity. The quiz reflected quick thinking, teamwork, and a good understanding of commerce concepts.

Participants showed strong presence of mind and logical reasoning while responding to questions. The audience remained attentive and engaged throughout the session, creating an energetic and competitive academic environment.
