Subject: Report on Action Taken Based on 360-Degree Feedback from Students, Parents and Alumni for Session 2023-24

In reference to the letter No. dated 26/07/2024 Chairperson ME constitutes a committee and committee meeting on 17/08/2024 for the above said subject. The committee discussed the 360 degree feedback from different stockholder and suggested the following actions to be taken to improve quality standards

1. Introduction

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has compiled feedback from students and alumni of the Mechanical Department to assess and address the key concerns affecting the quality of education and overall student experience. The feedback highlighted several critical areas needing improvement, including infrastructure, canteen facilities, hostel accommodations, and laboratory facilities. This report outlines the actions taken by the Mechanical Department in response to these concerns.

2. Identified Issues and Actions Taken

a. Building Infrastructure

Issue: The feedback indicated that the building infrastructure is inadequate and does not meet the needs of students effectively.

Actions Taken:

Assessment and Planning: A comprehensive assessment of the existing building infrastructure should be conducted. Based on that assessment, a detailed plan for renovation and enhancement should be developed.

Immediate Repairs: Urgent repairs, including fixing leaks, painting, and upgrading electrical systems, must be initiated.

Infrastructure Improvement Plan: committee members' recommend that a proposal for the construction of additional classrooms, seminar halls, and administrative offices should be

submitted for approval to the competent authority. The project must be expected to commence in the next academic year.

b. Canteen Facility

Issue: The canteen facilities have been reported as inadequate, impacting student satisfaction and comfort.

Actions Taken:

Facility Upgrade: The canteen should be temporarily closed for renovation. Improvements include the installation of new kitchen equipment, better seating arrangements, and enhanced hygiene standards.

Vendor Review: A review of the food vendors should be carried out to ensure the quality and variety of food offered. New vendors with better offerings may be considered.

Student Feedback: A student feedback mechanism is being established to continuously monitor canteen services and address any issues promptly.

c. Hostel Facility for Boys

Issue: There is currently no hostel facility available for male students, which has been a significant concern.

Actions Taken:

Feasibility Study: A feasibility study for the establishment of a boys' hostel has been completed. This includes site selection, budgeting, and planning.

Approval Process: The proposal for the hostel construction has been submitted to the management and is under review. We are working to secure funding and initiate construction as soon as possible.

Interim Measures: In the short term, arrangements are being made to assist students in finding nearby rental accommodations.

d. Laboratory Facilities

Issue: The laboratories are reported as outdated and insufficient for current educational needs.

Actions Taken:

Equipment Audit: An audit of existing laboratory equipment should be completed to identify outdated and malfunctioning items.

Upgrade Plan: A committee should be drafted to make a plan for upgrading laboratory equipment and facilities. This should include the acquisition of modern machinery and tools.

Funding and Procurement: Budget proposals for the procurement of new equipment should be submitted. Efforts should be made to secure additional funding through UGC/AICTE grants and Alumnae industry members.

Training: Lab assistant should be appointed and Faculty members and lab should be trained to handle new equipment and incorporate modern teaching methodologies into their practical sessions.

3. Future Plans

Monitoring and Evaluation: A monitoring mechanism will be established to regularly assess the effectiveness of the implemented actions and make necessary adjustments.

Continuous Feedback: Ongoing feedback from students and alumni will be sought to ensure that all issues are addressed promptly and effectively.

Reporting: Regular updates on progress will be provided to the IQAC and other relevant stakeholders.

4. Conclusion

The Mechanical Department is committed to addressing the concerns raised by students and alumni through a structured approach and timely actions. We believe that the above suggestion will significantly improve the quality of infrastructure, facilities, and overall student experience in the department.
