The following agenda was discussed in the meeting.

- 1 The minutes of the 20th departmental meeting was confirmed.
- 2 It was proposed to update and revise the M.Sc. Chemistry Syllabus. It was unanimously decided that the faculty members who are teaching M.Sc. Chemistry shall submit the course wise revised syllabus to the M.Sc. Course Coordinator by 19th May 2025 after due consultation with other faculty member of their respective specialization.
- 3 It was proposed to design the B.Sc. Chemistry Syllabus for 5th and 6th Semester as per NEP-2020. It was unanimously decided that the faculty members who taught B.Sc. Chemistry 5th and 6th Semester in past shall submit the course wise revised syllabus to the B.Sc. Course Coordinator by 19th May 2025 after due consultation with other faculty member of their respective specialization.
- 4 In any other item, it was unanimously decided that the students of M.Sc. Chemistry should be allotted specialization in equal proportion of existing strength in Inorganic/Organic/Physical on the basis of their merit (SGPA of M.Sc. 1st Semester). In case of tie, the specialization shall be allotted on the basis of marks obtained in their respective theory subject (Inorganic/Organic/Physical) of M.Sc. 1st Semester. It was further resolved the case may be submitted to the next PG-BOS for further consideration and approval.
- 5 The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
