The University community is hereby notified that, recognizing the cultural significance of the Diwali festival, the Competent Authority has approved and formally declared October 23, 2025 (Thursday) and October 24, 2025 (Friday) as institutional holidays.

This decision has taken specifically to enable university staff and students to celebrate this festival week with their families. This gesture reflects a profoundly positive and supportive attitude on the part of the authorities towards the well-being and cultural needs of the entire university community.

Additionally, to ensure the minimum statutory requirement for teaching hours is fulfilled, these two days will be compensated by declaring **November 15, 2025 (Saturday)** and **November 22, 2025 (Saturday)** as **mandatory full working days**.

All University Teaching Departments (UTDs) must adhere to the following schedule:

- The Time-Table of October 23, 2025, will be followed on November 15, 2025.
- The Time-Table of October 24, 2025, will be followed on November 22, 2025.

All students and staff are requested to note this change and plan accordingly.
