It is informed that 3rd and 4th counselling of the leftover/vacant seats for admission to the M.Tech. (CSE) programme for the Academic Session 2026-27 will be conducted on **03.08.2026 at 9.00 AM onwards**, as per the attached admission guidelines.

The updated vacant seat position after the Second Counselling is given below:-

Please note the following:

1. As per the admission guidelines, all seats (except supernumerary seats) remaining vacant after the 3rd Counselling, irrespective of category, shall be converted into the All India Category (AIC) for the 4th Counselling.
2. The 4th Counselling shall be conducted on the same day i.e. 03.08.2026 immediately after the completion of the 3rd Counselling.
3. The above vacant seat position is provisional and subject to change depending upon admission withdrawals/cancellations, or other changes occurring before the counselling process.
4. Other instructions and guidelines will remain same as notified alongwith merit list of M.Tech (CSE).

GUIDELINES FOR 2nd COUNSELING

- The 2nd Counseling will be conducted for all categories, namely RoHC, HOGC, SC (by merging SC and SC-D in SC), BC (by merging BCA and BCB in BC), PH and merging all ESM (all priorities) and FF with 25% Horizontal Female reservation.
- In case the quota reserved for physically handicapped candidates remains unutilized due to the non-availability of suitable handicapped candidates, those seats may be offered to:
Ex-Servicemen and their wards (1%)
Dependents of Freedom Fighters (1%).
- Parallel offline counseling will be conducted for supernumerary seats, i.e., Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) seats, along with the above counseling process.
- For Kashmiri Migrants (KM), a separate offline counseling process will be conducted alongside the above counseling.

GUIDELINES FOR 3rd COUNSELING

- In the 3rd Counseling, all vacant seats under the Rest of Haryana Category (RoHC) shall be merged into the General Category for all candidates, including Haryana candidates in the All India category (AIC).
- In the 3rd counseling, admission shall be made after merging the subcategories (including females) of a particular reserved category into the main reserved category, i.e., AIC/SC/BC.

GUIDELINES FOR 4th COUNSELING

- In the 4th Counseling, all vacant seats in any category shall be merged into the All India category (AIC).
