Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Professor and Dr. Sandhya Dixit, Professor Committee members could not attend the meeting.

At the outset, Dr. Hari Om, Chairperson, welcomed all the members. Thereafter, the agenda item was taken up and after detailed discussion, the following decisions were taken :

Item No.	Details
DRC/ 01	To consider the extension of Ph.D. registration of Mr. Surender Singh (20-YMCA-910004), for a period of one year under supervision of Dr. Om Prakash Mishra and Dr. Krishan Kumar Verma. An application from Mr. Surender Singh (Registration No. 20-YMCA-910004) requesting an extension of his Ph.D. registration for a period of one year was received, seeking additional time to complete his research work and submit his Ph.D. thesis. The Supervisor, Dr. O.P. Mishra, has informed that the research scholar has substantially completed his research work titled "<i>Green Investigation and Trends in the Automobile Sector</i>", including literature review, development of research methodology, data collection and analysis, and preparation of research findings. He has also been engaged in the preparation and publication of research papers related to his research work. However, certain essential components of the research—such as data analysis/validation, revision of research work, publication of research papers, thesis writing, and finalisation of results—require additional time for proper completion.

	The requested extension will enable him to satisfactorily complete the remaining research activities and submit his Ph.D. thesis in accordance with the prescribed academic requirements of the University. The six-year Ph.D. duration for Mr. Surender Singh will conclude on 27/10/2026. In view of the above, the Committee considered the matter and recommended to the Competent Authority the approval of a one-year extension of his Ph.D. tenure, i.e., from 28/10/2026 to 27/10/2027, to allow the research scholar to complete the remaining academic formalities, including thesis compilation and submission.
DRC/02	To consider the extension of Ph.D. registration of Ms. Chanchal Bhardwaj (20-YMCA -912002), for period of one year under supervision of Dr. Rajeev Kumar Saha and Dr. Rishi Pal, Professor, Dept. of Psychology & Behavioral Science, SVSU. An application from Ms. Chanchal Bhardwaj (Registration No. 20-YMCA-912002) requesting an extension of her Ph.D. registration for a period of one year was received, seeking additional time to complete her research work and submit her Ph.D. thesis. As informed by her supervisor, Dr. Rajeev Saha, the research scholar has completed her research work titled "<i>The Role of Psychological Capital and Mindfulness in Employees' Wellness of Manufacturing Industry Personnel.</i>" Due to unavoidable health-related circumstances, the research work could not be completed within the prescribed duration. It is expected that she will be able to complete the remaining work within one year. The prescribed duration of six years for Ph.D. completion will conclude on 20/11/2026. In view of the above, the Committee considered the matter and recommended acceptance of her request for a one-year extension of Ph.D. tenure, i.e., from 21/11/2026 to 20/11/2027, so that the research scholar may complete the remaining academic formalities, including thesis compilation and submission.
DRC/03	To consider the request for conversion of Ph.D. registration from Full -Time Mode to Part-Time Mode of Mr. Sandeep Kumar Sharma (20 YMCA 517018) under supervision of Dr. Rajesh Atttri and Dr. Sanjeev Goyal. A request from Mr. Sandeep Kumar Sharma (Registration No. 20-YMCA-517018) for the conversion of his Ph.D. registration from Full-Time Mode to Part-Time Mode was received and placed before the DRC for consideration. As informed by the Supervisor, Mr. Sandeep Kumar Sharma was admitted to the Full-Time Ph.D. (ME) programme on 12.03.2025 and has successfully completed the prescribed coursework. His application for the AICTE Doctoral Fellowship was not approved, and he is presently not receiving any scholarship or financial assistance. Under these circumstances, it has become extremely difficult for him to manage

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	day-to-day expenses as a Full-Time research scholar. As per the provisions of the University's Ph.D. Ordinance, a Full-Time Ph.D. scholar may be considered for conversion to Part-Time mode after completion of 18 months from the date of admission. It is to be noted that Mr. Sandeep Kumar Sharma will complete the required period of 18 months on 11.09.2026. In view of the above circumstances, the Committee deliberated on the matter and recommended to the Competent Authority the approval of conversion of his Ph.D. registration from Full-Time Mode to Part-Time Mode.
DRC/04	To consider the cancellation of Ph.D. registration of Mr. Sanjeev Kumar (21-YMCA -910007), under supervision of Dr. Mukesh Gupta and Prof. Raj Kumar A request for cancellation of Ph.D. admission of Mr. Sanjeev Kumar S/O Sh. Kila Ram (Reg. No. 21-YMCA -910007) was received from the Supervisor Dr. Mukesh Gupta to the Chairperson through Email on 11.08.2026. It has been reported that Mr. Sanjeev Kumar has not shown any progress in his research work to date and has failed to report despite repeated reminders, both telephonically and otherwise. He has exhibited no inclination towards pursuing his research work and has provided no logical explanation for his continued absence. After due discussion, the DRC Committee reviewed the matter and approved the cancellation of his Ph.D. registration, in accordance with the provisions of the University's Ph.D. Ordinance, clause 10 (snapshot is attached below). 10. Cancellation Rules (i) If the candidate is not able to submit the fees, the accounts section should send his/her name to the respective department and department will issue a letter to the candidate. If the candidate will not submit fees after two consecutive semesters his/her name may be stuck off from the rolls of University after the recommendation of chairman and supervisor. (ii) If the candidate fails to submit his/her progress report after every semester, after two consecutive such semesters, DRC may recommend the cancellation of admission. (iii) In case two consecutive six monthly reports are unsatisfactory, DRC may recommend for cancellation of the registration. (iv) If the supervisor feels that the candidate lacks interest and motivation for research after completion of course work, he can recommend his/her case to the DRC and DRC can recommend for cancellation of admission. Finally, the Academic Council, on the recommendation of the DRC, may cancel the registration of a research scholar.
