

World Earth Day - 2025 Celebrations organized by Department of Environmental Sciences and Vasundhara Eco-club

The Department of Environmental Sciences, in collaboration with Vasundhara Eco-Club, successfully celebrated World Earth Day on 22nd April 2025 at J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA, Faridabad, Haryana. The theme for this year's celebration was "Our Power and Our Planet", emphasizing the vital role of collective action in safeguarding our environment. The event commenced with a symbolic lamp-lighting and felicitation ceremony, symbolizing hope and commitment towards a greener planet. Shri Krishan Singhal, Deputy General Manager (Retd.), IOCL, Faridabad and Dr. N. P. Shukla, Former Chairman of the Commission for Air Quality Management in the National Capital Region and adjoining areas, New Delhi were the distinguished guests on the occasion presided over by Prof. Sushil Kumar Tomar, Vice Chancellor, J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology YMCA Faridabad. Deans, Chairpersons and faculty members of various departments were present on the occasion.

At the onset, Dr. Renuka Gupta, Chairperson of the Department of Environmental Sciences presented a welcome address, introducing the event's theme and highlighting the importance of sustainable living. In his presidential address, Vice Chancellor Prof. Sushil Kumar Tomar offered valuable insights on the importance of Earth Day and urged everyone to adopt a sustainable lifestyle to protect Mother Earth. He emphasized that by embracing sustainable living, we can mitigate climate change, ensure resource availability for future generations, and create a healthier planet. Shri Krishan Singhal, Deputy General Manager (Retd.), IOCL, Faridabad, enriched the audience with historical context about Earth Day, interlinking environmental conservation with teachings from the Rigveda, Bhagavad Gita, and Guru Granth Sahib. His address touched on significant challenges like rising AQI levels, solid waste management, battery waste from e-vehicles, the drying of Badhkal Lake, and biodiversity loss in the Aravallis. He highlighted the devastating effects of oil spills on marine ecosystems and called for active individual participation in environmental actions like afforestation, reforestation, carpooling, sustainable food habits, promotion of green buildings, and embracing the LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) initiative.

Dr. N. P. Shukla, Former Chairman of the Commission for Air Quality Management in the National Capital Region and adjoining areas, New Delhi, delivered an insightful keynote address. He discussed pressing environmental concerns such as climate change, global warming, ozone layer depletion, and pollution. Using Ratlam city in Madhya Pradesh as a case study, he illustrated the dangers of water pollution caused by improper industrial waste disposal. He also stressed the critical role of individual eco-friendly behavior and emphasized the contribution of Sal trees in rejuvenating water bodies.

The event concluded with a heartfelt vote of thanks by Dr. Anita Girdhar, Assistant Professor, Department of Environmental Sciences. The event was well coordinated by the organizing team members, Dr. Preeti Sethi, Dr. Sakshi, Dr. Harish Kumar, Dr. Sushma, Dr. Rupali and Dr. Divya Dhillayan alongwith research scholars and MSc EVS students of the department.
