

J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA, Faridabad launched the Gram Panchayat Scholarship Scheme during the Sarpanch and Principal Meet organized on the occasion of National Panchayati Raj Day. Representatives of various Gram Panchayats, school principals, academicians and distinguished guests participated in the programme.
