



Registration of final year students for online end-semester Examinations July 2020

As already notified, the University is conducting the end semester Examinations of final year students of all programmes in online mode, only for the students who are willing to appear, to avoid mass gathering during COVID pandemic. All such students need to register themselves on the University website www.jcboseust.ac.in/..... by clicking on "*I agree*" link at the end of this page. The Students of affiliated Institutions have to register through contacting their respective Institution. It requires webcam enabled PC/Laptop/Tablet etc with minimum 2G Internet connectivity. The students are advised to arrange the same. Any student who doesn't have this facility but willing to appear online may opt to appear in campus of the University /affiliated Institution, if so is convenient. Those students who are not able/ willing to appear in online mode may opt for offline mode of Examinations to be conducted later on by clicking on "*I don't agree*" link at the end of this page. The Students who are opting for online mode must note the followings:

- a) The Question Paper will contain Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)
- b) There will be 50 MCQs to be attempted in one hour. This duration and the number of questions may vary in case of few subject papers where the nature of question(s) may be deemed it appropriate, so as to enable the students to attempt accordingly. It will be clearly mentioned before start of the exam.
- c) A Demo test will also be arranged to make students familiar with the detailed procedure of these Examinations. Each student must participate in Demo test.
- d) During the exam, e-proctoring facility will be used to invigilate the students. Each and every student will be under e-surveillance through picture/video recording during entire duration of exam, using Artificial Intelligence as well as Online Invigilation by the Invigilators. No student will be allowed to use any unfair means. No other window/ program/app etc will be functional on the screen during the exam. Any attempt to do so will cancel the exam. Any unwarranted activity/attempt will lead to auto-issuance of warning to the student on his/her screen as well as to the Invigilator. Repeat of any such incidence will automatically cancel the exam and UMC will be registered instantly.
- e) In case of any genuine interruption during the conduct of any exam, the system will automatically freeze and save as it is. Reconnection to the server will restart from the point it was disconnected and not cause for any time loss/re-attempt.
- f) A helpline will also be facilitated for students to report any unexpected error. In such genuine cases, student will be allowed to restart the Exam.
- g) All further communications in this regard will be made through e-mail/sms to be provided by respective student during this registration. Please be careful in filling the same.
