Sub: Conduct of end term semester (odd) theory examinations of various courses

In continuation of above referred notices, all concerned are hereby informed that the end-term semester examinations which were earlier scheduled to commence w.e.f Jan 17, 2022 shall now commence w.e.f Feb 08, 2022 in both online/offline mode at the exam centers in respective Institutions. The pattern of exam will be as follows:

- a) Offline (Subjective) mode: Duration- 90 minutes. There will be total 6 questions. Question 1 will be compulsory and contain 10 short answer type questions. Remaining five questions will be medium answer type, out of which any 3 questions will have to be attempted.
- b) Online (Objective) mode: Duration- 75 minutes. There will be 50 multiple choice questions. It will require attempting the subject paper using the computer system at the examination centre. The test pins will be issued by the Invigilator.
3. The choices of mode of examinations have already been opted by the students and the same is being considered.
4. The revised Date sheet(s) for these examinations are being separately notified on the University website.
