Item No.AC/20/36: **To consider and approve the admission fees for foreign (Additional) students.**

It is submitted for kind information of the Council that the AICTE vide letter No.North-West/1-7010172592/2020/EOA dated 16/6/2020 granted approval for making admission of foreign students to 15% of the seats of 180 intake of B.Tech Computer Engineering from the session 2020-21.

The competent authority desired that fee of atleast \$2500/- (US) per annum may be charged from the foreign students. A copy of proposal submitted by Director, International Affairs Cell vide Note dated 07/08/2020 is attached herewith as **Annexure-20.36.01.**

The Council may kindly consider and approve the fee to be charged from the foreign students.

Item No.AC/20/37 : **To apprise regarding Pre-PhD. submission of Ms. Anubha Gautam (YMCAUST/PH14/2K11) on account of 2 papers in Scopus Indexed Journals, 2 in UGC approved journals and 2 papers in IEEE conference publications (without SCI Journals).**

It is submitted for information of the Council that Ms. Anubha Gautam (YMCAUST/PH14/2K11) registered in PhD in May, 2012 has requested to allow her to submit her PhD Pre-submission as per the PhD Ordinance vide her application as received through DRC on the recommendation of Supervisor on the basis of 2 papers in Scopus Indexed Journals, 2 in UGC approved journals and 2 papers in IEEE conference publications.

In this regard, it is further informed that last year on the recommendation of Dr. P.R. Sharma, Supervisor and subsequently Departmental Research Committee, an extension of one year (ending Nov. 2020) was granted so that the candidate may publish the paper in SCI journals and the same was also approved in 18<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb. 2020.

In the past University has also awarded PhD degrees to the students of the same batch without SCI publication.

The matter is placed before the Council for its kind information please.

**Subject: Administrative approval for admission of foreign students in B.Tech. (Computer Engineering)**

It is submitted that AICTE has granted approval for admission of foreign students to our University for the B.Tech. (Computer Engineering) under categories 'PIO / FN / Gulf quota/ OCI' vide F. No. North-West/1-7010172592/2020/EOA dated 15/06/2020. In this regards the AICTE guidelines as per 'AICTE Approval Process handbook 2020-21' specific to foreign students, the seat reservation, eligibility, fee and admission procedure are attached as Annexure 1 for your ready reference.

Since 180 seats has been approved under regular B.Tech. (Computer Engineering) program, 15% of the seats of 180, accounts for 27 seats under foreign students. Out of these 27 seats, one-third i.e. 9 seats are reserved for Gulf Quota (AICTE handbook 2020-21).

As per AICTE guidelines, Admission to these seats shall be made on merit basis among Applicants of these categories. However, no rule is mentioned regarding the eligibility of foreign students to B.Tech program.

So, the admission procedures opted by our peer Universities are also surveyed and summarized in Table 1 (Annexure II) for your kind reference. They have set the eligibility criteria for foreign students equivalent to eligibility criteria for resident students.

Our University may also consider same guidelines for the purpose of admission of foreign students to B.Tech (CE), stating that final merit list of foreign students for admission shall be made as per the percentage of marks of qualifying examination. i.e. Senior Secondary [10+2] or equivalent from any system of education as recognized by AIU. Further, Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with any one of Chemistry/ Bio-Technology/ Biology/ Technical Vocational subject. Furthermore, the student must have obtained minimum 45% marks in above subjects (basis our University guidelines for resident students).

Regarding fees to be charged from Foreign students, the guidelines as per AICTE handbook 2020-21 is as follows, "The concerned State Government/ UT shall notify the tuition and other Fee for candidates admitted under Foreign Nationals/ OCI/ PIO seats. However, the children of Indian workers in the Gulf Countries shall be treated at par with resident Citizens if admitted to seats reserved for them i.e. One Third (1/3) of 15% supernumerary seats. The Fee prescribed for NRI seats shall not be applicable to this admission."

The fees charged by Kurukshetra University and GJU, Hisar, (Annexure 2) is \$2000 per annum. Accordingly, the fees to be charged for Foreign Nationals/ OCI/ PIO seats may set to \$2000 per annum. Fees for children of Indian workers in the Gulf Countries shall remain same as per University charges for resident students.

You are requested to accord administrative approval for admission of foreign students in our University as per details mentioned.
