It is submitted for kind information of the Council that as per the existing *Credit Transfer/Mobility Policy of Online Courses* approved by the Academic Council in its 17th Academic Council dated 11.06.2019, the MOOCs offered in a particular semester need to be approved through Academic Council for credit transfer.

It is proposed to consider and approve all MOOCs on offer on the SWAYAM Portal for credit transfer, so as to avoid repeated course approvals in each semester by Academic Council. However, it would be ensured that the courses on offer on SWAYAM portal and selected for credit transfer by UTDs/affiliated colleges should meet the selection conditions as laid down in the already approved policy.

The Council may kindly consider and approve the above proposal submitted by the Nodal Officer, Digital India Cell of the University.

(ii) To consider and approve MOOCs offered through SWAYAM Portal in the semester July-December, 2019.

The Council is further requested to approve the MOOCs offered to the students for credit transfer through SWAYAM Portal in the semester July-December, 2019.

After visiting the documents/ website of other State Govt. University it has been found that some Universities are already offering admission to foreign students.</p> <p>The above proposal is placed before the Council for kind consideration and deciding the seats for admission under the category of foreign students/NRI in the UGC and AICTE approved courses.</p> <p><u>STATEMENT OF THE CASE:-</u></p> <p>It submitted that having seats for admission under the category of foreign students/NRI in the university, will also help in securing points while applying for NIRF, NAAC, NBA etc. The AICTE portal will open in the month of January, 2020 for applying sanction of foreign student/NRI seats in the courses being run with the approval of the AICTE. But in the meantime, we may create seats in the courses being run under UGC with the approval of the competent authority/body for the seats as may be decided by the Council.</p>
