

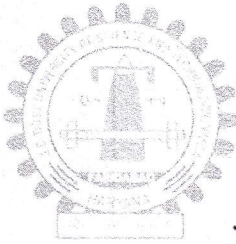
ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF 360⁰ FEEDBACK SYSTEM (2019-20)

A 360 degree feedback was taken on online platform from various stakeholders like alumni, parents, students and the peer group.

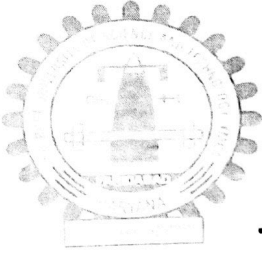
Action taken on the basis of feedback received:
